À la fin de votre LLM

L'obtention du LLM dépend de votre réussite aux évaluations organisées par l'université à la fin de votre semestre (rendu d'un mémoire à la fin de la formation). La période d'évaluation est incluse dans la durée du semestre.

À noter : la réussite au LLM ne conditionne pas la validation de votre PPI. Néanmoins, la formation doit avoir été intégralement suivie.

À l'issue de votre LLM, il faudra solliciter de votre université :

1. Un relevé des notes
2. Une attestation d'assiduité

CAPA - Evaluation de votre PPI

Le PPI sous forme de LLM est évalué en deux étapes dans le cadre du CAPA :

1. Rédaction et dépôt (dans les conditions qui seront précisées par le service des examens) d'un rapport sur le LLM en français, avec en annexe votre relevé des notes et votre attestation d'assiduité selon le calendrier disponible sur <https://wpvit.efb.fr/index.php/je-suis-eleve-avocat-a-lefb/je-gere-ma-formation/dates-cles-de-ma-promotion/>
2. Epreuve orale de soutenance basée sur le rapport lors des épreuves du CAPA.

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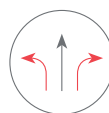

3. Await application decision

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis.

You may submit your application as soon as the admission campaign opens (usually around March/April). We encourage early submissions, as applications are reviewed individually and offers are made progressively until the cohort is full.

4. Confirm your seat: pay the tuition fees deposit

Candidates with a **Full Offer** will need to proceed with the payment of the minimum tuition fees deposit to confirm their seat in the programme. This payment should be made within 3 weeks following the receipt of the Acceptance Letter. Please refer to the Fees Planning document for details on the payment plan.

Candidates with a **Conditional Offer** will need to submit additional documents (e.g., transcripts or degrees, CRFPA results) as requested.
